Behind the Wheel Students and Parents,

We, at Behind the Wheel Driving School, want to thank everyone (both Students and Parents) for all your continued patience as we have been dealing with this mass Pandemic of COVID-19. Because of the nature of this virus and the problems associated with it, we have implemented new measures to try and prevent the spread of the virus along with keeping your new drivers safe while they are behind the wheel with our instructors. By signing at the bottom of this letter, we are asking you to consent to the new measures and understand that these will hopefully only be temporary measures but are in accordance with the CDC, the Health Department in Columbus, and the Cleveland Clinic Foundation.

Take your temperature before coming to the driving lesson. If it's above 100.2 or if you are ill, please let us know with at least a 24 hours notice. If you answer "yes" to any of the following screening questions, you can not come to the driving lesson for the safety of instructor and students. You may come 14 days after symptoms begin, providing that you have felt well for at least 3 days at that point.

Screening Questions:

- 1. During the last 14 days, have you had contact with anyone who has lab-confirmed COVID-19, is under investigation for COVID-19, or is hospitalized or being treated at home for a respiratory or febrile illness?
- 2. Have you or anyone living in your house had any of the following symptoms in the past 14 days:
- Fever or chills
- Unexplained cough, shortness of breath, or sore throat
- Pneumonia/flu symptoms
- Loss of smell or change in the sense of taste
- Tiredness, ache
- 3. Have you traveled out of state or had guests from out of state in the last 2 weeks?

The driving school vehicle's hot spots will be sanitized between students.

Please note that we have worked diligently to maintain a safe environment inside the driver's education vehicle.

Please wash your hands upon returning to your home.

Wash your hands often with soap and water for at least 20 seconds especially after you have been in a public place, or after blowing your nose, coughing, or sneezing

If soap and water are not readily available, use a hand sanitizer that contains at least 60% alcohol

Requirements for safe In- Car Instruction:

- 1. All students must bring their own masks and they are required to wear the mask during the driving lesson. If you do not have a mask, one can be provided by Behind the Wheel School of Driving for a nominal fee of 5.00 with 24 hours notice sent by email so that we can accommodate your teenager with our cloth mask.
- 2. For your protection, our instructors have all been provided masks that will be worn during the driving lesson.
- 3. We have purchased disposable thermometers to confirm that each student is fever free at the start of the lesson. Any student who has a fever of 100.2F or higher will not be permitted to have a driving lesson.
- 4. The 50.00 cancellation fee will not apply in the event that your child has a fever at the time the temperature is taken.
- 5. All instructors will have their temperatures taken as well each morning prior to the start of their shift.
- 6. Should you decide to wear gloves during the lesson, that is completely fine and any other preventative measures that you decide to do prior to the lesson, is encouraged and appreciated.

We want to ensure that your experience with Behind the Wheel Driving School is at the highest level and we will do what we can to assure you that your child is protected at all times. If possible, the windows in the vehicle will be opened to allow fresh air.
